- What happens in 1 Sam.23:26-29? What does David do as a result?
- o How have you seen God act as the Rock of Escape in your life?
- What would you do if your family/friends betrayed you like what happened to David in 1 Sam.23:11-12, 19, Psalm 54 intro?
- o How does David deal with this in Psalm 54:5?
- o How should we handle our enemies according to Romans 12:19-21?
- Psalm 54:4 centers our need for God to be our help. Look up the following verses about God as our help, and discuss what that means?

- o Psalm 121:2, John 14:26, Psalm 34:17-18, Psalm 46:1-3.
- How might we praise God in our times of lament? Use Psalm 54:6-7
